Key elements of successful rotations

Rotations:	Actions/expectations required for a rotation:
Start with a nonverbal signs Are completed in 30 seconds (or less!)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Standing up for rotation ● Sitting down after rotation ● Moving on the path ● Signaling for help/assistance when at computer ● Behaving at the computer ● Logging-off and prepare to leave computer stations ● Knowing assigned computer/small group seat ● Responding to a rotation mistake or a breach of expectations
All Students:	
Move at the same time Move in the same direction Move in a line and do not cross paths Follow voice expectations Move to an assigned seat at each station **If these expectations are not met, DO. IT. AGAIN.

M	Movement	Stand up Walking in a line
V	Volume	Silence Quiet Voice Level 0
P	Participation	Logging in quickly Getting books out Putting scissors away Push Chair in Hands at side
